

RICCARDO REDAELLI – SHORT C.V.

Riccardo Redaelli is the Director of the Center for Research on the South System and the Wider Mediterranean (CRiSSMA) and Director of the Master in Middle Eastern Studies (MIMES), at the Catholic University of the S. Heart, Milano, where he teaches History and Geopolitics and Geo-history, Institutions of Asia, Post Conflict and Emergency Management. In 2021, he became President of the Italian Society of International History (SISI).

Since 1990, he carried out field work research in the wider Middle East, especially in Pakistan, Iran, Iraq. He coordinated also a plurality of programs of post conflict institution building and/or national reconciliation, as well as Track-2 workshops sponsored by the Italian MFA, the European Commission and by American Foundations in several Countries of the region (including Pakistan, Afghanistan, Iran, Iraq, Libya).

He published more than 100 monographs, edited books, essays and articles on the history and contemporary politics of the Middle East. In 2021, he edited (with Francesca M. Corrao) the book: *States, Actors and Geopolitical Drives in the Mediterranean. Perspectives on the New Centrality in a Changing Region* (Palgrave Macmillan).
